**THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD
FEAST DAY SATURDAY 6TH AUGUST**



In the Transfiguration, Jesus disclosed his divine glory for a brief moment, giving confirmation to Peter's confession. The presence of Moses and Elijah as witnesses implies that the Law and the Prophets testify to the coming of the Messiah, now identified as Jesus. The cloud, so consistent with the theophanies of the Old Testament, revealed the presence of the Holy Spirit. As St Thomas Aquinas noted, the Transfiguration included the whole of the Trinity: "The Father in the voice; the Son in the man; the Spirit in the shining cloud."

St John Vianney would often say:

"Private prayer is like straw scattered here and there: If you set it on fire, it makes a lot of little flames. But gather these straws into a bundle and light them, and you get a mighty fire, rising like a column into the sky; praying together at mass is like that."

St John Vianney's Prayer:

I love you, O my God, and my only desire is to love You until the last breath of my life.

I love you, O my infinitely lovable God, and I would rather die loving You, than live without loving You.
I love You, Lord and the only grace I ask is to love you eternally...

My God, if my tongue cannot say in every moment that I love You, I want my heart to repeat it to You as often as I draw breath.

What does the rich man do, surrounded by a great supply of many blessings beyond all numbering? In distress and anxiety, he speaks the words of poverty. He says, "What should I do?"...
