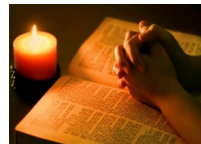

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

Mount Carmel is commemorated in Scripture for its beauty; it is the place where the prophet Elijah defended the purity of Israel's faith in the living God. Towards the end of the 12th Century, a group of hermits established themselves on Mount Carmel and built an oratory in honour of Our Lady. They became known as the 'Brothers of St Mary of Mount Carmel'. Our Lady of Mount Carmel was first celebrated in England in the 14th Century and the commemoration was adopted throughout the Carmelite order as an occasion of thanksgiving.
