




If your child is at least 7 years of age and your family attends Mass in our parish, you may enrol your son/ daughter in our Preparation Programme.

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

Mount Carmel 15 commemorated in Scripture for its beauty; it is the place where the prophet Elijah defended the purity of Israel's faith


in the living God. Towards the end of the 12th Century, a group of hermits established themselves on Mount Carmel and built an oratory in honour of Our Lady. They became known a the 'Brothers of St Mary of Mount Carmel'. Our Lady of Mount Carmel was first celebrated in England in the 14th Century and the commemoration was adopted throughout the Carmelite order as an occasion of thanksgiving.

Today's retiring collecting is for the Apostleship of the Sea.

Take Nothing Except A Staff: No Bread, No Bag, No Money

To Whom Addressed. Are all commanded not to have two coats, nor food in their possession, money in their purse, only a staff in the hand and shoes on the feet? Are all commanded to sell all they possess and give it to the poor, and follow Jesus? Of course not. This command is for those who earnestly desire to respond fully to grace The Lord says in the Gospel to him who had boasted of having kept the whole law: "If you will be perfect, go and sell all that you have, and give to the poor, and come, follow me." He said this to those who wish to be wholly mature in faith, that he might not seem to be laying a heavy burden on unwilling shoulders.
